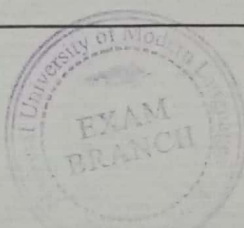

KEY TO TRANSCRIPT

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Grade points of each course are determined by multiplying the numerical Grade by the number of credits for the course. A Grade Point Average of 2.00 is required for graduation from the University for a Bachelor's & 2 years Masters Degree.

Cumulative Grade Point Average appears on the Transcript of total semesters in the end of the Program.

To compute the Cumulative Grade Point Average, divide the total point earned for all semester by the total credits taken for those semester.

GRADING RANGES

To rate students' academic performance, the following grades are applied at corresponding percentage marks. Grade Points are also indicated:

GPA Calculation

The Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated as follows:

$$\text{GPA} = \frac{(\text{Course Credit Hours} \times \text{Grade Points Earned})}{\text{Total Semester Credit Hours}}$$

$$\text{CGPA} = \frac{(\text{Course Credit Hours} \times \text{Grade Points Earned})}{\text{Total Credit Hours Taken in all Semesters}}$$

Only two types of GPA will be used; Semester GPA (SGPA) and Cumulative GPA (CGPA). SGPA is the weighted average of grade points earned in one particular semester where as CGPA is the weighted average of grade points in two or more semesters. The change in status of student will take effect from the date of announcement of result of repeated / improved course

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
