Eligibility:

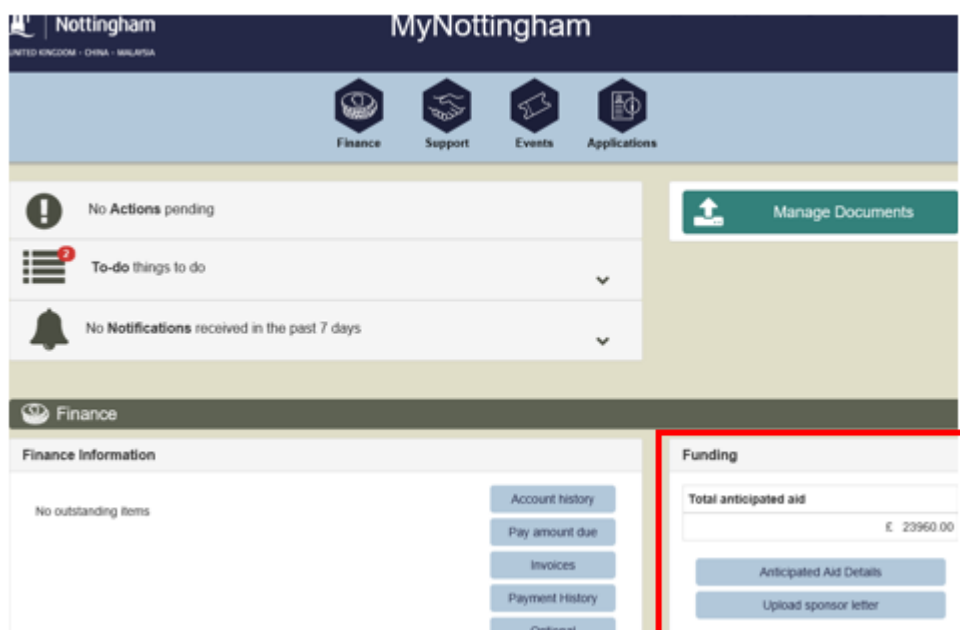
In order to be eligible for this scholarship you must accept your offer to study at the University and meet any conditions attached to it. You must also register as a **full time** student, classified as '**Overseas**' for fees purposes for all international scholarships. Full terms and conditions can be viewed at [Scholarship Terms and Conditions](#), and it's important that you read and understand these. You must inform us of any other scholarships/sponsorship currently held, or awarded to you at a later date. Our scholarship may be adjusted or withdrawn if other sources of funding have been awarded.

Please follow the steps below to accept your scholarship:

Reply directly to scholarship-assistant@nottingham.ac.uk confirming acceptance of your scholarship by the 13th of July and quote the following information:

- Your applicant ID
- Your full name
- Your Date of Birth
- Reference number: **PN7ZcDcE**
- Body of text "I accept the scholarship" or, should you chose to do so "I decline the scholarship"

On receipt of your email the University will manually apply the scholarship to your record. The scholarship will be visible in the "Finances" section of MyNottingham within 5 working days from the receipt of your email (see example below).



You must reply to this email quoting reference number **PN7ZcDcE** to accept your scholarship. Please note the **deadline for accepting your scholarship is 12 midnight (UK time) Friday 13th of July**.

Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) for Visa Purposes:

If you are applying for a student visa under Tier 4 of the Points Based System you will require a CAS which contains information about you and your course. A CAS is not an actual certificate or paper document. It is a virtual document similar to a database record. Each CAS has a unique CAS Reference Number. Our Admissions Office will contact you by email about your CAS up to four months prior to the start of your course providing you have:

1. Firmly accepted your unconditional offer and
2. Paid any required deposit (only applicable if you are a Masters student on a partial scholarship).

Adding the Scholarship to your CAS:

1. Where a scholarship is awarded **before** your CAS has been created, information about the tuition fee scholarship will be automatically added to your CAS **once you have accepted the scholarship**. Admissions will send you an email which will link to a **CAS checking document**. You should check this carefully to ensure that your scholarship has been added. If scholarship information hasn't been added, follow the onscreen instructions (which will be included in the email) and add details of the missing scholarship when asked to do so. Scholarship details will be added to your CAS within 5 working days and you will be notified of this. You will also be asked to check the CAS checking document again to confirm that all of the information (including the scholarship information) is correct.
2. Where a scholarship is awarded **after** your CAS number has been assigned, then you just need to accept the scholarship and it will then be added to the CAS within 5 working days and you will be notified of this.

If you need to show the tuition fee reduction on your CAS because you do not have sufficient funds to pay it yourself then please do not submit your Tier 4 visa application online until you have received confirmation that the scholarship has been added to your CAS. If this is the case, and you do not receive notification of the scholarship being added to the CAS within 5 working days, you should email scholarship-assistant@nottingham.ac.uk with your full name, scholarship reference and your CAS number.

If you have already submitted your visa application because you have enough funds to cover the required tuition fee and living costs then you do not need to do anything else. The tuition fee reduction will be applied to your account and any overpayments will be usually be refunded once you have registered.

Please note: If you have been awarded a stipend in addition to your tuition fee scholarship then this information must be manually added once your CAS number has been assigned. If this is the case then you will be sent a separate email with instructions on how to get this information added to your CAS.
