Thesis Summary:

Motivation

Caliph Umar ibn al-Khattab (R.A.) holds a very important place in Islamic legal history. He was known for making independent legal decisions through *ijtihad*, and many of these decisions were later confirmed by Qur'anic revelation. This connection between human reasoning and divine guidance is called *muwafaqat Umar*. Despite its great importance, this topic has not been studied enough through classical Qur'anic commentary. This research aims to fill that gap by studying how Tafsir Tibyan al-Qur'an explains this phenomenon, and what it tells us about the relationship between human reasoning and divine guidance in Islamic jurisprudence.

Research Methodology

This research is qualitative in nature and is based on library research. To study the topic properly, analytical and critical methods were used. The main sources used in this study are Tafsir Tibyan al-Qur'an, the Holy Qur'an, and Hadith literature. Alongside these, classical books on Islamic law and Qur'anic interpretation were also consulted, as well as some modern scholarly works. The whole process involved carefully reading, comparing, and analysing these sources to understand how Caliph Umar's legal decisions are discussed and explained within the tafsir tradition.

Obtained Results

This study found that Caliph Umar often made legal decisions on his own, and interestingly, many of these decisions were later supported by Qur'anic revelation. Tafsir Tibyan al-Qur'an covers these cases well and explains them in a clear way. The research also shows that Caliph Umar had a very deep understanding of the Qur'an and the Prophet's teachings, which guided his legal thinking. What makes this especially interesting is that his reasoning so often matched divine guidance. In the end, this study adds something valuable to our understanding of early Islamic law and shows how important classical Qur'anic commentary is in explaining it.
